Welcome to the 2021-22 school year! We are excited to have students in school, five days a week, all year long! After last year, we are committed to doing what is necessary to protect in-person learning, but we will all have to work together to accomplish this task. Sheridan students need to be with their peers and the staff. To protect our ability to offer in-person instruction all year long, here are a few reminders:

Face masks for the time being are required, for staff and students while in school, during school hours. The Oregon Health Authority will review data monthly to determine when to remove the rule. Face masks are not required during lunch, playing a musical instrument by mouth, outdoors, or while practicing or participating in competitive sports.

Face masks are required while on school buses.

Face masks are also required indoors in all district buildings, at all times, following the Governor's statewide mandate.

Preschool children are not required to wear face masks.

Other health and safety protocols, such as hand washing and regular cleaning of high use areas, will also be in place.

Should students refuse to wear a face covering, the school will follow the same process for all other behavior expectations.

Again, these health & safety measures are in place to keep our schools open for the entire 2021-22 school year. I am looking forward to getting to know students, supporting in-person instruction and creating a safe place for active learning!
