Dear Sheridan Families,

Recently we learned of a confirmed student case of COVID-19. We completed our contact tracing and determined which students need to quarantine. Those parents have been notified directly.

As a reminder, please keep students quarantined for 14 days if there is a confirmed case of COVID-19 in the household. It is also important that students stay home when showing the following symptoms:

- Fever 100.4 or greater or chills
- New cough and/or difficulty breathing
- New loss of taste or smell
- Headache with stiff neck or with fever
- Diarrhea
- Vomiting
- Skin rash or open sores
- Red eyes with eye discharge
- Jaundice, yellow color in eyes or skin

Keeping students home from school when they are ill or directly exposed to COVID-19 will greatly help in keeping students in school and our schools open for the 2021-2022 school year.

Additionally, please contact your medical doctor and our district nurse if your child has been exposed to someone with COVID-19. Your child will most likely need to quarantine for 14 days. To contact the district nurse, please call (503)-508-8257.
