Dear Sheridan Families,

This last spring, Sheridan School District received two large grants, one for K-8 enrichment camps and the other for high school academic programs. This funding allowed us to create four weeks of summer programs, providing students with learning opportunities and/or high school credit. We are excited to provide students with summer programs, with over 300 students participating!

Recently, the Oregon Department of Education sent notification that the health and safety protocols, for the most part, are up to the school district. Given this change, we have decided to use the following guidelines for summer programs:

- Face masks are only required when students and staff are inside and unable to social distance.
- Face masks are required when on a bus.
- Staff and students will social distance whenever possible, based on the activity and type of instruction needed.
- Students will be seated six feet apart for lunch.

Please help us by having your contact information correct along with the emergency contact information. It is also important that students stay home if they are not feeling well.
