Dear Sheridan Students & Families,

This packet includes information about our Hybrid Learning model, timeline for in-person instruction, a Question & Answer document and the guidance from the Oregon Health Authority for when to keep students home. The Question and Answer document will be updated as needed and posted on the Sheridan School District website. The one contained in this packet is updated as of February 18th.

Below you'll find information specific to our Hybrid Instructional model. This will be in place when students return in-person on their assigned days/times. To help clarify things, **CDL** refers to students receiving their instruction 100% online through Comprehensive Distance Learning (CDL). **Hybrid Learning** includes both in-person and online instruction.

## Grades K-3

### Two options for students:

- ❖ **CDL** - Comprehensive Distance Learning
  - Students receive 100% of their instruction online.
  - If families choose to remain in the CDL learning model, then students will have an online morning and afternoon session. Live teaching online will be part of each day.
- ❖ **Hybrid Learning** - combination of in-person and online learning
  - Teachers at the K-3 level will teach to the whole group (class) and to small groups, focusing on reading foundations, writing skills and math fundamentals.
  - Students attending during the morning session will be with their grade level teacher from 8:00 am to 10:45 am on campus.
  - Students attending during the afternoon session will be with their grade level teacher from 12:30 pm to 3:15 pm on campus.

As an example, 1st grade student Doris Springer with an AM in-person session for **Hybrid Learning** would have a schedule that looks like this:

## Grades 4-5

### Two options for students:

- ❖ **CDL - Comprehensive Distance Learning**
  - Students receive 100% of their instruction online.
  - If families choose to remain in the CDL learning model, then students will have an online morning and afternoon session. Live teaching online may be part of each day, but pre-recorded modules will be the main instructional model.
- ❖ **Hybrid Learning - combination in-person and online learning**
  - Homeroom teachers will schedule students to come onto campus.
  - Students will be assigned two morning sessions per week from 8:45 am to 11:30 am.
  - Students, when not attending in-person, will complete independent online sessions in the morning.
  - All students will have an online learning session in the afternoon, as assigned by the teacher.
  - As the district moves forward, more times for in-person learning will be added.

Here is an example, 5th grade student Emilie Knutson, assigned Monday/Tuesday in-person for **Hybrid Learning** would have a schedule that looks like this:

## Grades 6 - 12

### Two options for students:

- ❖ **CDL - Comprehensive Distance Learning**
  - Students receive their instruction 100% online.
  - Students will have class online from **8:00 - 10:55 AM** Monday - Thursday.
  - Students will be introduced to new concepts and will be assigned tasks that can mostly be completed during morning sessions. Some tasks may need to be completed after morning sessions when live instruction is not taking place. Teachers will be available via Canvas email or during assigned office hours to answer questions or to provide student support.
- ❖ **Hybrid Learning - combination in-person and online learning**
  - All Students (grades 6 - 12) will attend online classes from **8:00 - 10:55 AM** Monday - Thursday, with their CDL peers, being introduced to new concepts and being assigned tasks that can mostly be completed during class. Some tasks may need to be completed after the morning session and can be done during afternoon in-person sessions or independently as needed.

### Afternoon In-person sessions:

- Faulconer-Chapman Grades 6-8
  - Students with last names starting with letters **A - L** will attend in-person afternoon sessions Mondays and Tuesdays from **12:25 - 3:20 PM**.
  - Students with last names starting with letters **M - Z** will attend in-person afternoon sessions Wednesdays and Thursdays from **12:25 - 3:20 PM**.
  
- Sheridan High School
  - Students with last names starting with letters **A - K** will attend in-person afternoon sessions Mondays and Tuesdays from **12:20 - 3:12 PM**.
  - Students with last names starting with letters **L - Z** will attend in-person afternoon sessions Wednesdays and Thursdays from **12:20 - 3:12 PM**.

As an example, 7th grade student Dean Rech with **Hybrid Learning** would have a schedule that looks like this:

It's important to note that new concepts will only be taught during online instructional time in the mornings so both CDL and Hybrid students will still be learning via online content. Teachers will be available via Canvas email to answer questions and students may be assigned to attend office hours with teachers to get caught up on work.
