




CLASS SIZE




ENGLISH LANGUAGE ARTS

Students meeting state grade-level expectations.




MATHEMATICS








BULLYING, HARASSMENT, AND SAFETY POLICIES

FCS has a zero tolerance for bullying and harassment and has outlined clear bullying, harassment, and safety policies to ensure our students have an environment conducive to learning. We encourage all reports of bullying to be brought to the attention of school staff immediately.

Our school is also participating in SAFE Oregon, which allows anonymous bullying tips to be reported through the SAFE Oregon network. In addition to bullying prevention, our school safety plan utilizes the Standard Response Protocol system to ensure that all staff and students are trained on school safety policies and procedures.
