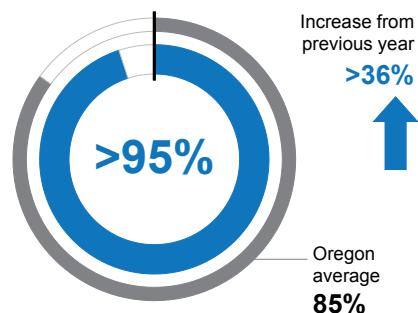
Students who attended more than 90% of their enrolled school days.

District Goals

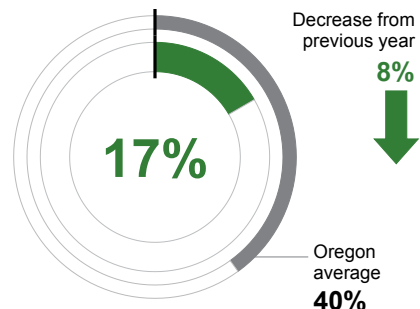

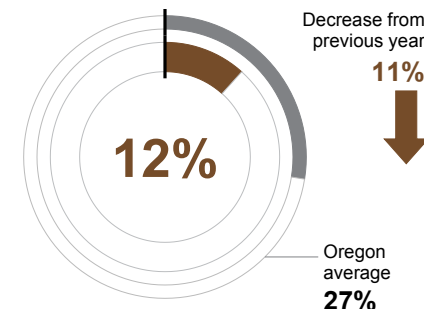
Students meeting state grade-level expectations.

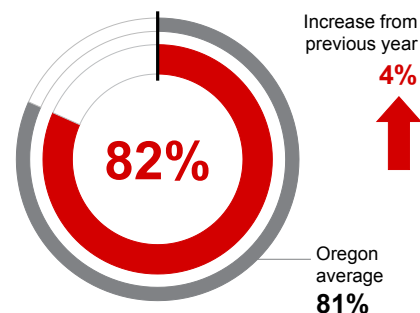

Students meeting state grade-level expectations.



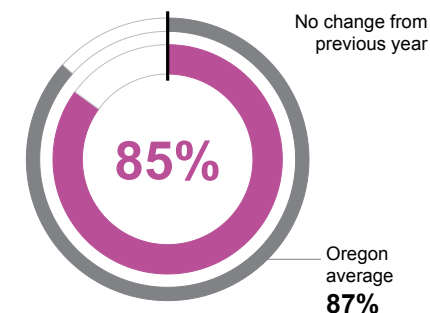
ON-TIME GRADUATION

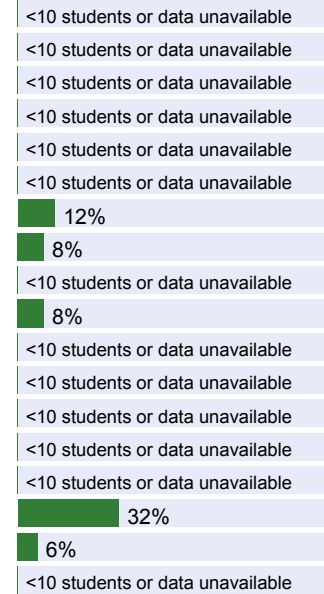

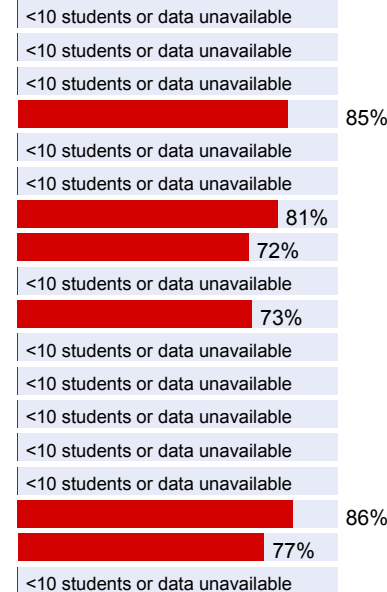

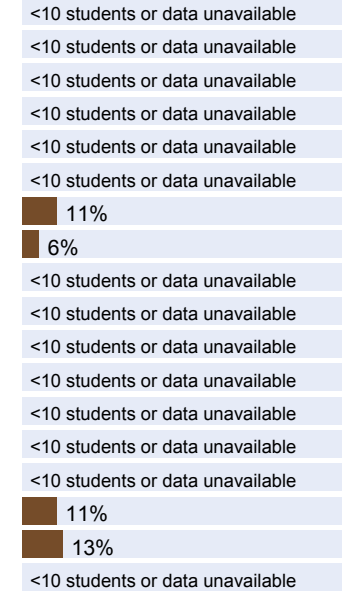
Grade 3 ENGLISH LANGUAGE ARTS
